Education in architectural and urban culture in the museum and in urban spaces

During the exhibition *Homo Urbanus - A Citymatographic Odyssey* (April 1 - August 27, 2023), the SAM Swiss Architecture Museum is launching a rich education programme for kindergartens, schools, universities, institutions and day centres. Dialogue-based guided tours and workshops within the current exhibition *Homo Urbanus - A Citymatographic Odyssey* are offered at the respective appropriate level, as well as Tandem guided tours in cooperation with Kunsthalle Basel. These can also be booked outside official opening hours, making it possible to have the unique experience of being alone in the museum. In addition, tours on foot or by bike are an invitation to make discoveries outdoors. Teachers are offered continuing education and training, so they can get to know the museum as an out-of-school education venue.

DIALOGUE-BASED GUIDED TOURS AND WORKSHOPS DURING THE EXHIBITION

Homo Urbanus - A Citymatographic Odyssey

How do people relate to the built environment? How do they inhabit this space, how do they appropriate it and how do they shape it? The film series *Homo Urbanus* by Bêka & Lemoine invites us to take in the rhythm of different space-time sequences and observe our individual and group behaviour as urban animals.

The S AM Swiss Architecture Museum and Kunsthalle Basel are connected not only by a shared roof, but also by their shared enthusiasm for art, culture and society. In this context, they combine contemporary artistic positions with current themes relating to architecture and urban development. On a joint tour, these synergies are made tangible and interfaces are laid out, while differences and significance to society are discussed.
