

## ARCHITECTURAL EDUCATION PROGRAMME

During the exhibition **Make Do With Now** (November 12, 2022 – March 12, 2023), the **S AM Swiss Architecture Museum** is launching a rich education programme for kindergartens, schools, universities, institutions and day centres. Dialogue-based guided tours and workshops within the current exhibition **Make Do With Now** are offered at the respective appropriate level, as well as Tandem guided tours in cooperation with **Kunsthalle Basel**. These can also be booked outside official opening hours, making it possible to have the unique experience of being alone in the museum. In addition, tours on foot or by bike are an invitation to make discoveries outdoors. Teachers are offered continuing education and training, so they can get to know the museum as an out-of-school education venue.

### IN THE MUSEUM

#### DIALOGUE-BASED GUIDED TOURS AND WORKSHOPS DURING THE EXHIBITION **Make Do With Now**

##### TOURS

We will embark on a discovery tour through the exhibition: Numerous architectural models, drawings, sketches and photos will allow us to experience contemporary architecture in Japan. The tour will be geared towards school levels.

##### WORKSHOPS

We will travel to Japan, discover new projects by Japanese architects and then get active ourselves. With thousands of Kapla wooden bricks we build our own project.

##### CULTURE UNDER ONE ROOF – Tandem guided tours at **S AM & Kunsthalle Basel**

The **S AM Swiss Architecture Museum** and **Kunsthalle Basel** are connected not only by a shared roof, but also by their shared enthusiasm for art, culture and society. In this context, they combine contemporary artistic positions with current themes relating to architecture and urban development. On a joint tour, these synergies are made tangible and interfaces are laid out, while differences and significance to society are discussed. The tour is geared towards the respective school level, and supplemented with interactive and participatory elements.
